Dr. Gary Namie taught the nation's first university course on workplace bullying. He was the expert witness in the nation's first "bullying trial" in Indiana with the verdict upheld by the state Supreme Court.

Dr. Namie and his wife, Dr. Ruth Namie, are the most recognized individuals associated with bullying in the U.S., due in large part to the eight public websites devoted to education about bullying for individuals, lawmakers, unions, and employers.

Their work has been featured on the *Today Show*, *Good Morning America*, CNN, NPR, and in print.

Gary Namie directs a national network of state coordinators (the Healthy Workplace Campaign), acting as citizen lobbyists, who work to pass into law the anti-bullying Healthy Workplace Bill.
