TABLE TENNIS RULES HANDOUT

ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. You must have a MTSU ID to participate. NO ID, NO PLAY...NO EXCEPTIONS!
2. No Person shall play on more than one single sex and co-rec team per sport. If caught doing so by supervisor or official, Player shall be suspended for remainder of season and that game shall be forfeited. Opposing team does not have to protest if caught by supervisor or official.
3. No person shall use false identification in order to participate. If caught, person will be suspended from Intramural Sports and possibly Campus Recreation activities for a period of time determined by the Associate Director of Intramurals, Sport Clubs, and Wellness.

THE GAME:

1. **The Table:** The table will be 9ft in length and 5ft in width and will stand 2ft 6in off the ground. The surface can be made of any material, as long as it yields a "uniform bounce" of about 8 3/4in when a ball is dropped from a height of 12in.
2. **Players:** All table tennis tournaments or league play will be 1on 1.

PLAYING REGULATIONS

- U.S. Table Tennis Association rules will govern play in the tournament.
- All matches played shall consist of the best two (2) out of three (3) games. A game shall be won by the player to first score twenty-one (21) points. A player must win by a two point advantage.
- Procedure: The matches will be self officiated.
If a dispute cannot be resolved by the individuals involved, play will be stopped immediately. The players involved must discuss the situation with the Intramural Sports Coordinator and play will resume accordingly from that conversation.
