- Location: Lanzhou, capital of Gansu Province, P.R. China

 - * Founded in 1902, originally as the Normal School of Beijing (Beijing) Teachers University, it moved to Lanzhou in 1944 during the Japanese invasion. It is now a comprehensive university.
 - * Has about 20,000 students
 - * Offers Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral degrees
