## BRASS CLINICS

Effective Audition Strategies – Maximize your potential in the highly stressful world of auditioning by attending this session with David Loucky, Jeff Bailey, and Gilbert Long. Whether for the New York Philharmonic or your high school band, auditions may be stressful for even the most seasoned performers. Learn strategies to prepare for auditions and to combat forms of performance anxiety.

Careers in Music and the Road to Success – This panel discussion led by Angela DeBoer will discuss various career paths within the music field. Particular attention will be given to the education, experience, and networking necessary to be successful meeting your goals in music.

Conducting – Discover a world of communicating music through movement and gesture. Dr. Reed Thomas, MTSU Director of Bands will present a hands on clinic on the art of conducting.

The Life of a Commercial Artist – Join Jeff Bailey for a session discussing the life of a commercial artist. In addition to being Co-Principal Trumpet of the Nashville Symphony, Mr. Bailey is one of the most recorded artists in Nashville.
